The Spiritual Battle Rages On!

Ephesians 6:10-20

Because the enemy is constantly waging war against us,
we need to go to spiritual war in the Lord's strength.
"Finally, be strong in the Lord and in the strength of his might." (v.10)

Please pray that we will...

Stand firm against the devil's schemes and lies. (v.11)

- *More awareness of the spiritual battle in and around us.*
- *More ability to identify and counter the spiritual attacks with Jesus' truth.*

Stand fast even when the spiritual battle is intense. (v.12)

- *Know that the battle is not against flesh and blood.*
- *A willingness to stand in and not run away when the going gets tough.*

Stand up to the enemy by suiting up in God's armour. (vv.13-17)

- *Diligence to daily be armoured up and ready to fight.*
- *Ability to continually rely on the weapons of war God has given us.*

Stand strong in the power of prayer. (v.18)

- *Clarity to see prayer as our ultimate defence and hope.*
- *Courage to pray in faith, even when we feel like we have nothing left.*
- *Confidence to believe that through Christ the war is already won!*

Stand boldly in the Gospel (v.19)

- *Nothing would stop us from preaching the Gospel and reaching out with the Good News.*
- *Gospel fruitfulness would overpower any and all opposition to Jesus.*

Fighting For Your Family!

1. Marriages built on Christ's example of love and submission.

"Wives, submit to your husbands, as is fitting in the Lord. Husbands, love your wives, and do not be harsh with them." (Colossians 3:18-19)

2. Parents with an increased passion to pursue discipleship in their homes.

"You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, and when you walk by the way, and when you lie down, and when you rise." (Deut. 6:7)

3. Children with a desire to honour God by honouring their parents.

"Honour your father and mother" (this is the first commandment with a promise), "that it may go well with you and that you may live long in the land." (Ephesians 6:2-3)

4. Families on mission together for the gospel.

"...to teach to their children, that the next generation might know them, the children yet unborn, and arise and tell them to their children, so that they should set their hope in God and not forget the works of God, but keep his commandments..." (Psalm 78:5-7)

5. Lost family members would come to trust Christ as Lord and Saviour.

"And he arose and came to his father. But while he was still a long way off, his father saw him and felt compassion, and ran and embraced him and kissed him. (Luke 15:20)
